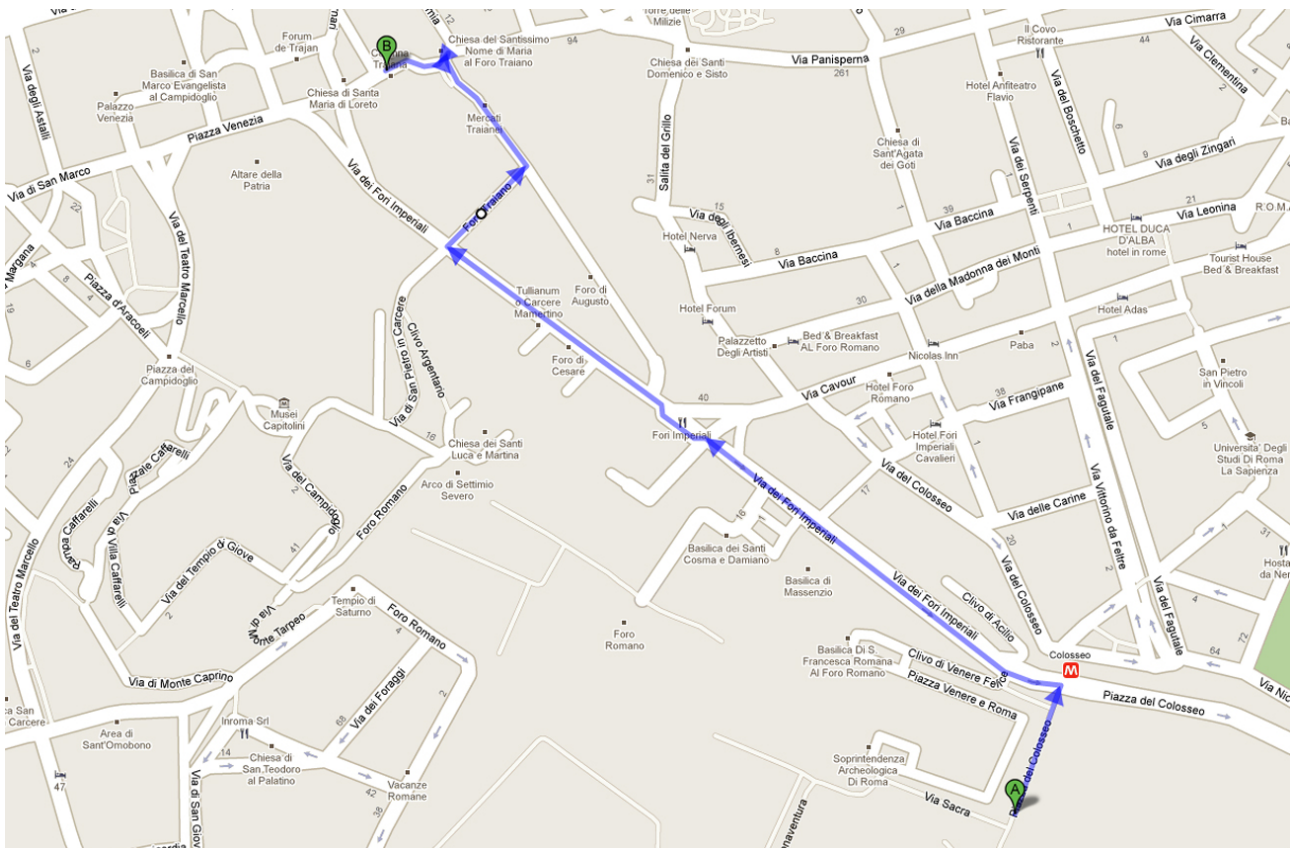


How many times, going to work or out shopping, have you quickly run down the Via dei Fori Imperiali, hurrying past the most extraordinary monuments of ancient Rome?

This CamminArte walking tour allows you to stroll among the impressive remains of our past and enjoy their beauty and history with a guide who will help you to understand their historic and artistic importance. During our walk we will look at the monuments around the Colosseum, not just the Flavian amphitheatre itself, but also the Arch of Constantine and the Temple of Venus and Rome.

We will then continue down the Via dei Fori Imperiali to admire the Roman Forum, the Forum of Julius Caesar and the Imperial Forums (built by emperors from Augustus to Trajan). The architecture and art of these spaces allow you to travel back through the history and culture of ancient Rome and to appreciate the huge technical and engineering feats of the past

We will let the brick walls, columns, marble fragments and huge stone temples speak, so that it is the monuments themselves which tell their own story as they silently watch over the bustle of a modern European capital city.
